WHO WE ARE



The Iowa Games, a statewide Olympic-style competition, is the most well-known of the Iowa Sports Foundation pillars. Beginning as a one weekend event in 1987, the Iowa Games now includes over 40 sports and events, with participants from all corners of the state.

- Over 17,000 athletes, coaches and spectators
- 323 teams
- Host communities: 21
- Soccer reigns as the Iowa Games top sport with over 250 teams

Live Healthy Iowa (LHI) was launched in 2002 as a strategic health initiative for Iowans. Since its creation, LHI has worked diligently toward its mission to challenge all Iowans to improve their well-being through purposeful engagement.

- Nearly 15 million activity minutes reported through adult challenges
- 97 of 99 lowa counties represented
- Collaborated with nearly 40 communities to host local events, connecting with over 4,200 participants
- Engaged with 87 families through the annual Family Wellness Challenge, sharing healthy recipes and fun physical activity opportunities..



WHO WE ARE



The Iowa Sports Foundation is in its thirteenth year of building the Adaptive Sports Iowa (ASI) program. ASI's mission is to provide statewide leadership in the planning, promotion, education and organization of sports and recreational activities for Iowans with physical and vision disabilities.

- 56 cyclists and staff participated on the ASI Cycling Team presented by Iowa Farm Bureau during RAGBRAI and group rides throughout central Iowa
- Over 70 athletes with disabilities participated in the wheelchair tennis program
- In February, we hosted the 2024 Northern conference tournament which included 12 wheelchair basketball teams from around the Midwest.

The Iowa Senior Games, developed to promote lifelong health and wellness, offers several Olympic-style competitions for Iowans age 50 and over.

- Over 2,100 medals awarded in nearly 100 events
- Record number of athletes in 2024 at 1,052
- Participants from 30 states
- Oldest participant was 95 years young

The Iowa Sports Foundation (ISF) introduced the Des Moines Corporate Games in 2016, the Corridor Corporate Games (Cedar Rapids/Iowa City) in 2019, and added the Quad Cities Corporate Games in 2021. The Corporate Games is a company-based competition that enables and supports teamwork, company pride, and corporate wellness through healthy competition.

- 154 companies took part in the Corporate Games
- Over 80 sports, recreational activities, and challenges were held
- More than 32,000 employees participated





- The only National Congress of State Games (NCSG) member organization in the country to host Summer Games, Winter Games, Senior Games, Adaptive Sports and Corporate Games
- The Iowa Games hosts competitions in more cities throughout the state than any other State Games
- Live Healthy Iowa is the largest statewide wellness initiative in the country
- Iowa Sports Foundation has participation in all of Iowa's 99 counties
- Iowa Sports Foundation hosted events in 63 communities across the state



Marty McHone Iowa Games Athlete of the Year

In 2003, the Iowa Games Athlete of the Year award was renamed after Marty McHone who was the 1996 Iowa Games Female Athlete of the Year, and had competed in the Iowa Games track meet for 16 years. The award is given annually to two Iowa Games athletes who best exemplify the qualities of outstanding integrity, citizenship and athletic achievement.
